COMPETITION HIGHLIGHTS

- The cut was to 69 players at even or better
 - Notables to make the cut:
 - Anna Huang** sits at T7 and is the low Canadian at –7
 - Has only had two over-par holes all tournament
 - Defending champion and Canadian **Brooke Henderson**
 - Three-time CPKC Women's Open champion **Lydia Ko**
 - Won last time this event was held at Royal Mayfair Golf Club
 - 14-year-old Monday qualifier and amateur **Kelly Zhang**
- The top 18 golfers have all had two rounds in the 60s, the most since the 2021 Pelican Women's Championship, where the top 22 golfers all had two rounds in the 60s
- Most Canadians to make the cut since 1996 (7)
- Most amateurs to make the cut since 1973 (4)

- Most Canadian amateurs to make the cut since 1978 (3)
- Leader: **Miyu Yamashita** sets the 36-hole CPKC Women's Open scoring record at 126
 - The 126 total is the lowest 36-hole score since Inbee Park at the 2014 Fubon LPGA Taiwan Championship
 - It is also the lowest 36-hole score of her career by seven shots
 - Has the fewest putts through two rounds with 50
 - Most birdies made in the field with 16
 - Second time holding the 36-hole lead or co-lead on the LPGA Tour
 - Converted the first time into a win at the 2025 AIG Women's Open
- T2: **Soo Bin Joo, Yuri Yoshida, and Kiara Romero** all sit at 9-under-par
 - Joo recorded a 7-under 63 in her second round
 - Went bogey-free
 - One of eight players to do so
 - Recorded the low round of the day
 - The 63 is her lowest 18-hole score at any LPGA event
 - Carded seven birdies, tied for second most in the field during the second round
 - Yoshida carded a second consecutive round in the 60s
 - Has missed the cut in six consecutive previous starts
 - Recorded six birdies and two bogeys in her second round
 - Her 131 total through two rounds is her lowest on the LPGA Tour
 - Her previous low was 135
 - Romero has recorded a 131 in two rounds in her first professional start
 - Ranks top 10 in birdies made, fewest bogeys, and greens in regulation
 - Her first-round 64 was the lowest opening round in a LPGA Tour debut since Jaravee Boonchant at the 2023 Honda LPGA Thailand
 - Earned her LPGA Tour card through LEAP last week

- First start at the CPKC Women's Open
- 2026: 15 cuts made in 17 starts with one win and seven additional top 10 finishes
 - Won the Meijer LPGA Classic for Simply Give
 - Missed the cut in her last start (AIG Women's Open)

- Made 10 consecutive cuts before the missed cut
- Career: Three wins, one major championship, 20 top 10s, and \$5.5M in official career earnings
 - Won the 2025 AIG Women's Open to become a first-time major winner
 - 2025 Louise Suggs Rolex Rookie of the Year
 - Represented Japan in the 2024 Paris Olympics (T4) and in the 2025 Hanwha LIFEPLUS International Crown
 - Earned medalist honors at Final Qualifying of LPGA Q-Series in 2024 to earn LPGA Tour membership

Miyu Yamashita (1st, -14) on if she is comfortable with the lead

"Rather than focus on the score, I'm thinking about how I can make birdies. So I will try to keep a good rhythm in the final rounds."

Soo Bin Joo (T2, -9) on the Birdies For Heart donations

"It's just I think -- I mean, golf is not only about golf, it's about like life, you know, like caring others and everything. And I think that's really sweet of CPKC doing it. I wish I can make more."

Yuri Yoshida (T2, -9) on making the cut after missing it in her last six starts

"Actually, I was a little bit nervous before started this tournament because I couldn't make the cut six tournament in a row. It's my first time in my career. So I'm happy to play on this weekend."

Kiara Romero (T2, -9) on having her brother on the bag in her professional debut

"Yeah, I feel like regardless of how I'm playing out there, you know, we'll be out there laughing and having fun and just kind of talking about everything but golf. It really just keeps me grounded out there and keeps my mind off the stakes out here. It's a lot of fun."

Kelly Zhang (T37, -2) on making the cut as a 14-year-old

"It feels so good because I played in the AJGA Mizuho Americas Open, too, and that was like my first like half LPGA I guess. And after the rounds there I compared myself to the LPGA, and I saw like a lot of room for improvement. Like this time I'm happy to be able to compete against them for real this time, and I am very happy to make the cut."
