COMPETITION HIGHLIGHTS

- **Leader: Miyu Yamashita** ties the LPGA Tour 54-hole record at 191
 - The 191 total was previously recorded by Hyo Joo Kim at the 2026 Ford Championship presented by Wildhorse Pass
 - It is also the lowest 54-hole score of her career by nine shots
 - Has the fewest putts in the field through three rounds with 79
 - Her 22 birdies led the field
 - First time in her career that she has held a lead through 54-holes at an LPGA Tour event
 - Her best position after three rounds prior was T2 at the 2024 KPMG PGA Championship
- **T2: Gina Kim and Yuri Yoshida** are tied for second and sit at 13-under
 - Kim carded a 64 for her best score through three rounds
 - Her 64 ties her best round in her career at an LPGA Tour event
 - Last time was at the 2023 The Standard Portland Classic
 - Recorded seven birdies and one bogey in her third round

- Her 46/54 greens in regulation through 54-holes is tied for the most in the field
- Yoshida shot her second straight 66 to get to 13-under
 - Ranks top 10 in birdies made (17) and fewest bogeys (4)
 - Her 197 through 54-holes is her lowest on the LPGA Tour in her career
 - Her previous lowest was 200 recorded at the 2023 TOTO Japan Classic

WITH A WIN

Miyu Yamashita

- Earns her fourth career victory
- Earns her second win of the 2026 LPGA Tour season
 - Joins **Jeeno Thitikul, Haeran Ryu, Nelly Korda, Hyo Joo Kim, and Hannah Green** as multi-time winners this season
- Would become the fastest Japanese player to four wins, 42 starts
- Would earn four wins in four different countries (Canada, United States of America, Malaysia, Wales)
 - Only the second player to earn four or more wins in four or more countries (Other was **Ha Na Jang** in United States, Singapore, Chinese Taipei, Australia and Republic of Korea)
- Would become the second Japanese player to record multiple wins in consecutive seasons
 - Other was **Ayako Okamoto** with three straight multi-win seasons, 1986-1988
- Would become the fifth Japanese player to have at least two multi-win seasons
 - Joins **Ayako Okamoto, Hiromi Kobayashi, Ai Miyazato and Nasa Hataoka**
- Would be the first Japanese player to win multiple times in a single season, other than herself, since Hataoka in 2021
- Would earn her ninth top-10 of the 2026 LPGA Tour season
- Would become the fourth wire-to-wire winner of the 2026 LPGA Tour season
 - Joins **Nelly Korda** (The Chevron Championship), **Lauren Coughlin** (Aramco Championship) and **Jenny Shin**
- Would surpass \$2 million in season official earnings
- Would surpass \$2 million in single season official earnings for the second consecutive time

Rolex Rankings No. 7 Miyu Yamashita

- First start at the CPKC Women's Open
- 2026: 15 cuts made in 17 starts with one win and seven additional top 10 finishes
 - Won the Meijer LPGA Classic for Simply Give

- Missed the cut in her last start (AIG Women's Open)
 - Made 10 consecutive cuts before the missed cut
- Career: Three wins, one major championship, 20 top 10s, and \$5.5M in official career earnings
 - Won the 2025 AIG Women's Open to become a first-time major winner
 - 2025 Louise Suggs Rolex Rookie of the Year
 - Represented Japan in the 2024 Paris Olympics (T4) and in the 2025 Hanwha LIFEPLUS International Crown
 - Earned medalist honors at Final Qualifying of LPGA Q-Series in 2024 to earn LPGA Tour membership
