Today – Drier conditions will prevail today with skies to gradually clear into the afternoon. Post-front, westerly winds will remain breezy with occasional gusts near 26 mph possible. Additionally, temperatures will trend cooler today with high temperatures to peak in the upper 70s by the afternoon hours.

Extended forecast – For the remainder of the weekend, dry and breezy conditions will continue through much of Saturday before another frontal boundary passes through the region during the evening to overnight. An isolated shower or storm cannot be ruled out in the late afternoon to early evening though much of the activity will favor after sunset. Remnant showers or storms are forecasted to exit Sunday morning – after 8am – as drier conditions return throughout the day. Winds will trend a bit less though remain breezy on occasion. By the beginning of next week, drier conditions will prevail with westerly winds to remain slightly increased. Additionally, a cooling trend will persist with overnight lows in the 50s and high temperatures in the 70s.
