**Today** – Showers will remain in the vicinity early this morning before drier conditions are likely to return later this morning into the afternoon. Ahead of a frontal boundary overnight, isolated pop-up showers or storms cannot be ruled out early this evening. Warm conditions will persist today with feels-like temperatures near 90F by the afternoon. West to southwesterly flow is forecasted to increase to 6-13 mph with occasional gusts within 20-25 mph possible.

**Extended forecast** – Heading into the weekend, drier conditions may return throughout Friday post-front with breezy to gusty conditions forecasted. The next frontal boundary currently favors late Saturday evening into the early morning hours on Sunday with isolated stronger storms possible. Any remnant activity will gradually progress eastward Sunday with slight chances for redevelopment later in the afternoon. A gradual cooling trend will continue over the next few days with high temperatures to trend in the 70s to low 80s and overnight lows to settle in the 50s.
