Today – Drier conditions and mostly cloudy skies will hold through the morning with temperatures to gradually warm. By the late afternoon, ahead of an approaching boundary, an isolated shower or storm is possible in the area. Temperatures will peak near 90F with feels-like temperatures slightly warmer in the mid 90s. West to southwesterly flow is forecasted to increase to 6-12 mph with gusts around 20 mph possible. Increased chances for showers and thunderstorms will favor after 8pm with isolated stronger storms possible.

Sunrise: 5:55am / Sunset: 9:18pm | Rainfall: 0.15-0.30", higher amounts likely in storms.

Extended forecast – Throughout the overnight Wednesday into early Thursday morning, the more robust shower and storm activity will make its way eastward bringing a brief period of drier conditions during the day on Thursday. Ahead of an approaching cold front, an isolated shower or storm cannot be ruled out favoring the late afternoon. Thereafter, increased chances of showers and thunderstorms will return to the area – primarily after sunset – as the front moves eastward. Isolated stronger storms will once again be possible in the overnight period. The next boundary will favor late Saturday into early Sunday morning. Outside of precipitation, breezy to gusty conditions may develop towards the weekend. A gradual cooling trend will bring highs to the 70s and lows to the 50s.
