Grass Types and Cutting Heights

Tees

The teeing areas are Bentgrass and are mown to .400 each morning.

Fairways, Approaches and Collars

The fairways are Bentgrass and mown to .450" each afternoon. Approaches and Collars are Bentgrass and mown to .400" each morning.

Putting Greens

The putting greens are Bentgrass/Poa annua and are single cut to .115" each morning with a roll applied. Targetted tournament speeds are 11.5 - 12.0.

Golf Course and Site Information

Midland Country Club, founded in 1928 by Dr. Hale, Gilbert A. Currie along with Dr. Herbert H. Dow. The original golf course design was overseen by Mr. Currie and he was named the first president of the newly formed Club. All 18-holes officially opened on July 1, 1928. The clubhouse you see today was constructed in 2009 and officially opened on Mother's Day 2010.
