Today – Low clouds in the area this morning and a chance of patchy fog prior to 8am. Otherwise, dry through the morning, with a chance of a few scattered showers/t-storms after 12pm, highest chance between 2-6pm. Any t-storms that do develop will be capable of brief heavy rainfall. Winds today will be light, generally from the southwest. Highs this afternoon reach near 82F and lows tonight fall to 59F.

Rainfall: 0.25-0.50", locally 1" with the heaviest storms.

High temperatures reach the low to mid 80s this weekend, warmest on Sunday.
