Fortinet Founders Cup at Sharon Heights Golf & Country Club



Aon Insight

The 14th hole at Sharon Heights Golf & Country Club presents an early scoring opportunity, but it requires a thoughtful decision off the tee. Measuring just 244 yards from tee to green, players must decide whether to attempt to drive the green or lay up for a short pitch. Accuracy will be critical, with bunkers guarding both sides of the hole. The first bunker sits approximately 60 yards short of the green, while five greenside bunkers protect the putting surface from multiple angles. With a green that slopes predominantly from right to left, players who choose the aggressive line will need precise distance and control to give themselves a realistic birdie chance.

What is the Aon Risk Reward Challenge?

At the end of the regular season, the most consistent player on Tour, with the lowest average score under par, on the Aon Risk Reward Challenge holes captures the \$1 million prize and the Aon trophy.

Aon's Risk Reward Challenge Scoring

One hole is selected at each tournament as the designated Aon Risk Reward Challenge hole for the week (hole is strategically challenging in nature).

For every participating event, a player's best two scores on the designated hole counts towards the season-long leaderboard.

The player with lowest average score under par across the regular season wins the Aon Risk Reward Challenge and will be awarded at the CME Group Tour Championship.

Aon and the PGA TOUR

The 2026 season will showcase the continuation of Aon's partnership with the PGA TOUR, which will integrate the use of real-time analytics and capitalize on changes to the TOUR's reimagined 2026 schedule.
