Extended forecast – Dry conditions, mostly sunny to partly cloudy skies, and generally calmer winds will continue through Friday. By Saturday, a frontal boundary may influence scattered to isolated rain showers early in the morning. Winds likely to pick up behind the front bringing wind gusts up to 30mph. High temperatures daily will hover in the middle 50s to low 60s though overnight lows will be near freezing. With lighter winds expected in addition to dewpoints below freezing, early morning frost through midweek will be possible. Much colder air will usher into the area by Sunday morning with a hard freeze possible.
