*Thitikul on her stats from last season and if she looks over them in an effort to help win a major championship*  
“Not really yet. I mean, like with all the numbers we got last year, it’s kind of unbelievable. And then I don’t know if I can be able to do that again this year because, you know, I don’t know how many numbers that have been really improving from last year, more than last two years. So I just trying to keep the number the way it’s like that and then I’m not really talking about the goals that kind of -- results at that go that much. The win, major win. I definitely think that he would thought in his mind but what he didn’t say it to me and I didn’t say anything because he know that my personality is that I’m not going to say about the wins at all. So that’s why. We just work, hit balls, balls, balls, putts, yeah.”

"Well, for instance, so when I played last time I hit gap wedge into last hole; yesterday I hit 4-iron. It was cold and a little bit wind into. Didn't feel like it was super windy but it was just because it was so cold. Yeah, it's going to be tricky out there. I think it's good when it plays tricky. I enjoy playing tougher golf courses. I enjoy the challenge. I just want it fun. You just put me on the golf course, I'll enjoy it anyway. I'm like, okay, let's get excited for the next shot and prove to myself that I can execute the shot."

"I've been a member here for quite a while now and I still sometimes read the greens the other way round. I think there are subtleties on the green and quite a bit of grain. And just because the greens are a lot faster and the course is in pretty pristine condition, the course does play a little bit different to maybe the middle of the year. But I think more than anybody else, I feel like the Nona members should at least know the course a little bit better. There is no tricks to it. What you see is what you get, but you do have to hit a lot of good shots and you do get rewarded being a little bit more aggressive and going for pins, especially the smaller sections. So just being really smart, know your way around the golf course is really important, and that's what I did really well in '24."
