**Tuesday** – Partly cloudy skies will clear out to become mostly sunny though the majority of the morning. A few lingering showers from overnight are in the area, but not expected to impact the course. Temperatures will rise to near 90F (32F) with a heat index above 105F (41C) by 9am. Between 1-3pm, thunderstorms are expected to develop in the vicinity and move towards the course. The threat of heavy rain and thunderstorms will persist through sunset. Winds will remain near 5-10mph.

**Extended forecast** – Wednesday is the last day with higher potential to see thunderstorms this week: again most likely between between 1-3pm. Drier air moves in overnight Wednesday through Friday. Winds are forecast to turn back to the southeast Thursday and Friday which will decrease the chances of rain and thunderstorms due to weaker moisture. A slight uptick in moisture and rain/thunderstorm chances returns on Saturday and Sunday. Heat indices will continue to exceed 105F each day after 9am.
