Wednesday – Partly cloudy skies will clear out to become mostly sunny though the majority of the morning. After 12pm showers and thunderstorms are expected to form in the vicinity of the course. The highest potential for thunderstorms at the course will be between 1-3pm. Any thunderstorms will move through quickly. The heat index is expected to reach 100F near 10pm and remain there through the afternoon. Winds will remain near 5-10mph.

Extended forecast – As the northeast monsoon weakens temporarily a drier airmass is expected to move over the Gulf of Thailand, leading to mostly sunny skies throughout Thursday and Friday. Winds are forecast to turn back to the southeast Thursday and Friday. Over the weekend and into Monday, a slight uptick in moisture and rain/thunderstorm chances returns on Saturday through Monday. Any storms will be isolated and quick moving. Heat indices will continue to exceed 100F each day after 10am.
