COMPETITION HIGHLIGHTS

- **Leader: Somi Lee** shot a career best 11-under-par 61
 - Previous best 18 holes was a 64 at the 2025 CME Group Tour Championship
 - Also broke her record for low 36 holes with a 127, previous best was a 132 at The 2025 Amundi Evian Championship and Black Desert Championship
 - Tied the tournament record for 18 holes set in 2025 by **Akie Iwai**
 - Went bogey-free and carded nine birdies and an eagle on No. 15
 - Hit 14/14 fairways, 16/18 greens in regulation and had 25 putts
 - This is her third time leading or co-leading after the second round
 - Previous times were at The 2025 Amundi Evian Championship (finished T14) and the 2025 Mizuho Americas Open (finished T11)
- **2: Jeeno Thitikul** recorded a nine-under-par 63
 - Carded seven birdies and an eagle on No. 7

- Is currently bogey free through 36 holes
- This is her best 18-hole round at the Honda LPGA Thailand
 - Previous best was a 64 recorded in 2025, 2023 and 2021
- Hit 13/14 fairways, 15/18 greens in regulation and had 25 putts
- Celebrated her 23rd birthday today
- T3: **Chizy Iwai** and **Lydia Ko** sit at 13-under-par
 - Iwai recorded her career low 18 holes with a 10-under-par 62
 - Previous best 18-hole score was a 64 at the 2025 Standard Portland Classic and the 2023 Toto Japan Classic
 - Went bogey free and had 10 birdies
 - Hit 13/14 fairways, 17/18 greens in regulation and had 26 putts
 - Twin sister **Akie Iwai** finished runner up at this event in 2025
 - Ko carded an 8-under-par 64
 - Went bogey free and had six birdies and an eagle on No. 15
 - Hit 13/14 fairways, 16/18 greens in regulation and had 28 putts
 - Making her first start at this event since 2023, finished T6
- Defending champion **Angel Yin** sits at T58 after a 3-over-par second round
 - Carded four bogeys and a birdie
- Thai amateur and sponsor invitation **Prim Prachnakorn** is currently T64
 - Carded rounds of 74 – 72 for a 36-hole score of 146
 - Will earn a LEAP point if she finishes in the top 40

Somi Lee (1, -17) on having her career low round

"I had the best score of my life today so I'm a little emotional. But since the competition is not over and there is still two more days left, I just want to celebrate this a little bit."

Jeeno Thitikul (2, -14) on celebrating her birthday today and the fans singing to her

"They're going to sing just only birdie putts. Just only birdie drops and then they all sing it. Obviously nice to have a lot of birdies today, which is hear a lot of happy birthday. The most time in my life. But obviously it's just really good memories that I have created with them on my birthday on the golf course again."

Chizzy Iwai (T3, -13) on Akie Iwai playing well at this event last year

"I saw so many Akie photo in the golf course so that inspired me."

Lydia Ko (T3, -13) on how she feels about her performance throughout the first two rounds

"Yeah, it's been a lot of solid golf. We've had a couple weeks off since our last event, so even though I played well at HGV it's hard to know where the game is heading. The last two days have been nice to see what we have been working on pay off on the course. Yeah, my ball striking is something that we've been trying to dial down, and especially my iron play. I think I had like my worst iron greens in regulation stats these past couple years, so that was something that was really high on my attention list. It's been a while since I hit 16 greens, so definitely nice to come off with a round like that. Yeah, especially with Jeeno playing well today I felt like the whole group was really able to get in a good momentum and make a lot of birdies out there."

Hannah Green (T5, -12) on how she is managing Siam Country Club

"Yeah, the par-5s are playing a little different to usual. They're actually a lot easier to reach besides the 18th hole, which they moved back the tee, but there is just so many birdies to be made. Every green has its quirks to it, but when you can see that ball roll in I feel like that gives you massive confidence. I feel like that's what ever you know was doing today, taking advantage of that. We see every year the scores are always super low, so hopefully I can keep my foot on the gas and try and catch Somi."

Mi Hyang Lee (T8, -11) on what went well during her round

"My putt was so hot. I'm glad to make a lot of putt, and then also I missed only two greens and 25 putts. Totally that means my shot was good too, but my putt was so hot. And then also I got the right shoulder injury and it's not 100% yet, so I couldn't do full swing yet, but still really happy to play back in here."
