Tuesday – Partly to mostly cloudy skies are expected throughout the morning and early afternoon. Moisture will continue to increase across the region throughout the afternoon. This may lead to scattered rain showers and thunderstorms in the area. The highest chance for thunderstorms at the course is between 3-5pm. Temperatures are expected to reach the upper 80sF (low 30sC) with a heat index near 95F (35C) in the afternoon. Winds will become breezy with 20-22mph wind gusts in the afternoon.

Extended forecast – High levels of moisture are forecast across Singapore this week. This is expected to lead to scattered rain showers and thunderstorms daily in the afternoons Wednesday through Friday. The highest chance for thunderstorms each day remains in the mid-late afternoon. Slightly weaker moisture may lead to less scattered activity over the weekend. Winds will remain breezy from the NE with 15-20mph wind gusts this week. The heat index is expected to range from 90F-95F (32C-35C).
