**Today** – Dry conditions are expected this morning with increasing cloud cover. A threat for showers and T-storms likely develops this afternoon with the highest risk between 2-6pm. While the main threat is expected before 6pm, a few more showers/T-storms could redevelop during the evening hours. Forecast rainfall: 0.25-0.50" w/ localized higher amounts in storms.

**Extended forecast** – Lingering moisture & instability could fuel a shower/T-storm Wednesday, however most development should stay north/east. The forecast will maintain dry conditions Thursday through Saturday although a shower threat is being monitored for Friday. Winds likely become a bigger factor by Saturday with gusts of 20-25 mph possible. Showers/T-storms could return Saturday night into Sunday morning but confidence in details is low. Gusty winds are also possible during the day Sunday with gusts near 30 mph.
