Today – Dry conditions and mostly sunny skies are forecasted during the day with generally calm winds through the morning hours. By the afternoon, west to southwesterly flow may slightly increase to 5-10 mph with the occasional gust near 15 mph possible. Cool temperatures will continue this morning before gradually warming to the mid 70s by the afternoon hours. Any rain chances will primarily favor the overnight – mainly after 1am – as a frontal boundary passes through the region.

Extended forecast – Scattered rain showers may linger until 8am Wednesday as the frontal boundary moves further east with mainly dry conditions to return thereafter. Additionally, west to northwesterly flow will increase post-front with sustained winds at 10-15 mph and gusts approaching 28 mph. Peak gusts within 30-35 mph cannot be ruled out, primarily after 1pm until sunset. For the remainder of the week, winds will gradually settle out of the southwest at 5-12 mph with occasional gusts to 20 mph. Any additional rain chances are favoring the weekend with the greatest potential on Saturday – isolated thunderstorms are possible within this activity. A gradual warming trend is forecasted this week with high temperatures to peak in the 80s and overnight lows to approach near 60F.
