Today – As a frontal boundary moves further east, rain showers may linger through 7am before dry conditions and clearing skies return to the area. Post-front, breezy winds may develop with west to northwesterly winds to increase to 10-15 mph this afternoon with occasional gusts approaching near 25 mph – primarily from 2pm-7pm. Temperatures will peak in the upper 60s before falling to the 50s after sunset.

Extended forecast – Dry conditions and generally calmer winds will maintain through Thursday. For the remainder of this week, daily chances for rain showers or storms will return to the area with the greatest potential to favor Saturday. Southwesterly flow will settle across the region at 5-12 mph with the occasional gust up to 20 mph possible. A general warming trend is forecasted over the next several days with high temperatures to peak in the upper 80s and overnight lows to occur in the low 60s.
