COMPETITION HIGHLIGHTS

- 65 players made the cut at -4 or better
 - Monday qualifier **Emily Netzbart** had a 5-under-par second round to make the cut
 - LPGA Tour Mom **Nicole Broch Estrup** made the cut at 5-under-par through round 2
 - Defending champion **Aki Iwai** missed the cut by three shots
 - All of the amateurs that received exemptions this week missed the cut
 - Farah O'Keefe** and **Maria Jose Marin** finished -3
 - Valentine Delon** finished even par after a -4 day
- Leader: **Arpichaya Yubol** carded a second consecutive round of 66
 - Had seven birdies in her second round of play
 - Has 13 birdies overall, tied for the second-most among the field
 - Has hit 26 of 28 fairways through 36 holes of play, the second-most among the field
 - Has just 47 putts, the fewest among the field

- This is the first time in her career she has led heading into the weekend and the third time in her career she has led after any round of play on the LPGA Tour
- Her 132 36-hole score is her career best by one stroke
 - Previous was 133 at the 2024 Walmart NW Arkansas Championship
- T2: **Pajaree Anannarukarn** had seven birdies and one bogey in her second round
 - Has 13 birdies through 36 holes, the second most among the field
 - Has just 48 putts, the second fewest among the field
 - Her 133 is her lowest 36-hole score of the season
 - It is her lowest since this event in 2025

- T2: **Sophia Schubert** had a second round 66
 - Carded seven birdies and a bogey
 - Her 133 sets a new career-best 36-hole score
 - Matched her low score of the 2026 LPGA Tour season
 - Missed the cut in her last LPGA Tour start at the 2026 KPMG Women's PGA Championship
- T2: **Hye-Jin Choi** went bogey-free on Friday
 - Recorded three birdies and an eagle
 - Has just one bogey on the week, tied for the second fewest among the field
 - Today was her third bogey free round of the season
 - Her 133 is her lowest 36-hole score of the season and lowest since the 2024 Amundi Evian Championship

QUOTABLES

Arpichaya Yubol (1, -12) on having only one bogey through 36 holes

"It's golf, so it's always happen. So for me, 36 hole just one bogey is amazing, so just a little bit of golf like always happen. Like you can make birdie, bogey, or even like double, but just how to manage your thinking, just keep like positive thinking, you still have two more day, and, yeah, just keep playing."

Pajaree Anannarukarn (T2, -12) on what she will focus on these next two rounds

"Again, I think I'll stick to my game plan. I didn't really hit a lot of fairways today so I'll try to work on that after this. So I'll hit the range. And hopefully just try to put myself in play and make some putts."

Sophia Schubert (T2, -11) on how this week is restoring her confidence

Yeah, I've missed quite a few cuts by one this year, so it's been tough on the confidence. I mean, it's been good and bad. I look at it two ways. If I make some more putts I'm right there, but I haven't been. So I really grinded this last five, six weeks, so being able to just put two really good rounds together has been great for my confidence so far.

Hye-Jin Choi (T2, -11) on how she is able to score so well at this course

"The par-5 on the course you can try to like two shot to make eagle chance or birdie chance and it helps to make a good score. And I feel like the green is really good and the speed is good too so if you aim what you want it kind of goes where you want. So I think that makes the course really scorable."

Rose Zhang (T5, -9) on matching the low round of the week

"I feel like I was just very consistent from tee to green; was able to convert some putts, which I feel like has been the tougher bit of my season so far. But I feel like I took a lot of positives out of today. Very happy with how I played. I definitely took some aggressive lines off the tee, so hopefully tomorrow can shape it up a little bit more."

Jeeno Thitikul (T5, -9) on what it's going to take for her to win here

"Birdies. I mean, of course birdies. Whatever you are on the top of the leaderboard, you definitely knew that you have to make birdies anyway no matter where you are. I mean, like even you're the leader you still had to make a birdie to not, you know, like don't come kind of low to everyone can catch you up."

Yealimi Noh (12, -8) on what is making this course so scoreable

"I think it's a little bit on the shorter side and just really gettable with the greens being receptive and the putts being really pure. Yeah, just hit a lot of greens and give yourself a lot of opportunities I think makes for good scoring."

Celine Boutier (T12, -8) on being named to the European Solheim Cup team

“Yeah, I'm super excited to be a part of this team again this year. I think our team is looking very strong and I'm really looking forward to playing again in Europe. I think it's going to be really fun to have some fans cheering for us this year.”
