Today – Partly cloudy skies and dry conditions will likely hold throughout the day. However, low chances for an isolated shower or storm cannot be ruled out this afternoon. Temperatures will warm to the upper 80s by midday with feels-like temperatures to trend in the mid 90s. In tandem, east to southeasterly flow will increase to 6-12 mph with isolated wind gusts up to 20 mph possible. Temperatures and winds will decline after sunset.

Extended forecast – Similar conditions will hold over the next few days with hot temperatures, partly cloudy skies, and slightly breezy winds during the afternoon. While conditions will likely remain dry, low chances for an isolated shower or storm cannot be ruled out. Late this weekend, a frontal boundary will gradually progress eastward through the Gulf bringing slightly increased moisture to the area. This may introduce chances for isolated showers or storms, primarily during the afternoon hours, with the greatest potential to favor late Sunday. In addition, southeasterly winds may increase to 7-14 mph with gusts up to 25 mph possible ahead of this approaching boundary.
