COMPETITION HIGHLIGHTS

- 65 players made the cut at +6 or better
 - Defending champion **Lottie Woad** shot -2 under in R2 and sits at even par total
 - Charley Hull** is +5 through 36 holes, making the cut after recording a nine in R1
 - Hull is the third player this season to make a nine or worse on a hole and make the cut
 - World No. 1 **Nelly Korda** is at +5 heading into the weekend
 - Amateur and sponsor invite **Kiara Romero** finished two shots outside of the cut line
 - Will play next week at the AIG Women's Open with her McCormack Medal exemption
 - Next week, she will need to make the cut to earn her last point toward LPGA Membership
- Leader: **Jenny Shin** recorded her second round of 67 or better
 - Shot the lowest round across the field on Friday
 - Has 13 birdies through two rounds, the most of any player in the field
 - Recorded 50 putts through two rounds, the least of any player in the field
 - Has not recorded a three putt through 36 holes
 - Has now recorded five consecutive rounds under par at this event
 - This is the longest active streak at the ISPS HANDA Women's Scottish Open
 - Third time in her career that she has led or co-led after the first and second round in an event

- 2019 Dow Championship
 - 2023 LPGA Drive On Championship
- Has one win on the LPGA Tour, which was 10 years ago at the 2016 Volunteers of America Texas Shootout presented by JTBC
- Her caddy, Shane Codd, typically caddies for Madelene Sagstrom
 - Codd has caddied for Shin in her past two events as Sagstrom steps away in preparation for her first child
- 2nd: **Esther Henseleit** shot a second-round 68; remains five shots behind Shin
 - Was one of two players to be bogey-free in R2 alongside Hye Jin Choi
 - Has only had two bogeys and 28 pars through 36 holes of play, each tied for the least amongst the field
 - Has eagled No. 3 each day; hit a 5-iron into the green in R1 and a 5-wood in R2
 - Has not won on the LPGA Tour yet
- **Minjee Lee** withdrew during the second round due to injury

QUOTABLES

Jenny Shin (1st, -11) on where she found her love for links golf

“Probably my first ever British Open at Carnoustie. I couldn't believe what I was seeing, what I was playing. One day it was blowing 40 miles. The next day, it's just calm. I had forgotten to play when it was calm. So I kind of fell in love, like this is a true test of golf. Like you have to be so creative, and I'm quite creative around the greens and I love hitting different shots. Yeah, I just kind of fell in love at Carnoustie for the first time. Very nice being over here, so I get to experience different kind of tests.”

Esther Henseleit (2nd, -6) on the challenge of links golf

“Yeah, it is nice to actually see this golf course play as a links course. I feel like the last few years, it was always super soft, and it was just like target golf with a lot of wind, and now you actually have to think about your shots, have to think about the bounces, and yeah, I always enjoy doing it. I don't want to do it every week of the year but two weeks of the year, it's definitely fun.”

Lottie Woad (T11, E) on battling through her round today

“Yeah, it was pretty windy at the start. Made an early double. So dropped two there obviously. Hit some really nice iron shots kind of for the rest of the day, fairways and greens. Didn't really make any putts to be honest with you. I could have shot a lot better but I was much more happy with how I hit it today compared to yesterday.”
