**COMPETITION HIGHLIGHTS**

- Winner: **Celine Boutier** overcame a 4-shot deficit to win by one stroke
  - Carded five birdies, a bogey and had only 26 putts
  - Became a two-time winner of this tournament, last won in 2021
    - Joins Juli Inkster, Betsy King, Annika Sorenstam, Stacy Lewis and Anna Nordqvist
  - Wins for the first time since The Maybank Championship in 2023
    - 954 days since her last victory on Tour

- Seven of the last 10 winners of this tournament were multiple shots back entering the final round
- **2: Arpichaya Yubol** had a final round 66
  - Had seven birdies and two bogeys
  - Second runner-up finish of 2026
    - Finished runner-up at the Riviera Maya Open at Mayakoba
    - First season she has had a runner-up finish
  - Was assessed a one-stroke penalty on No. 13 during her third round for slow play

- **3: Lauren Walsh** had a final round 67 to finish solo third
  - Had five birdies and a bogey
  - Is a rookie on Tour in 2026

### ABOUT THE WINNER

#### [Rolex Rankings No. 29 Celine Boutier](#)

- Earned her seventh career victory
- Became the first Frenchwoman to win on Tour since herself in 2023
- First player from Europe to win on Tour this season
  - The last player from Europe to win on Tour was Linn Grant at the 2025 ANNIKA driven by Gainbridge at Pelican
- Surpassed \$500,000 in season official earnings
- Surpassed \$9.5 million in career official earnings
- Became the eighth unique winner on Tour this season
- Career: Seven wins, 46 top-10s, \$9.5 million in career official earnings
  - Has won seven events including The 2023 Amundi Evian Championship for her sole major win
  - Winningest French golfer
  - Represented the European Team in the Solheim Cup in 2019, 2021, 2023, 2024
  - Represented France at the Olympics in 2020 and 2024

“Yeah, it's very special. It was my first win on the LPGA in the U.S., so it was already a special tournament for me, but to be able to come back this year and win it again is definitely making it even more special.

I think I have such great memories on this course and I've met such cool people during the pro-ams and stuff like that. Yeah, I feel like this week is definitely a lot of really good memories and very excited to also come back next year and defend.”

“It's going to be actually, how to say, it's a good day for me, so finish like second place for now.

Everything happen is happen. But I'm really happy, yeah.”

“100%. I feel like it's finally coming together and finally showing off on the course what I have been working on for so long. It's nice to see that, because it's so much hard work that a lot of the people don't see, a lot of tears that fell in the last couple years. Yeah, it's just really, really nice to see that showing off finally. Even with my team, everybody that stands behind me, has my back, roots for me, I'm just so happy that I can finally show that out here and play for everybody else and me. (Laughter.)”
