HONOURS EVEN ON DAY 1

For the first time in Solheim Cup history, both of the first two sessions of the competition resulted in a tie. With the final match of the day reaching the 18th, Carlota Ciganda holed a crucial par save from 12ft to tie the match alongside Julia Lopez Ramirez against Nelly Korda and Lauren Coughlin. It was the first time since 2002 that day one has ended in a tie. Alison Lee took two points for the U.S. Team at Bernardus Golf in the Netherlands, both times beating Celine Boutier and Nanna Koerstz Madsen – with Coughlin in the morning and Megan Khang in the afternoon.

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COMPETITION HIGHLIGHTS - FOURSOMES

- With the 2-up win during the morning session, **Leona Maguire** improved her career Solheim Cup record to 9-3-1 (.731).
 - Highest winning percentage for a European player in the history of this competition (minimum: 5 matches). Next on the list: Janice Moodie (7-2-2, .727), Carin Koch (10-3-3, .719), Annika Sorenstam (22-11-4, .649) and Catriona Matthew (18-11-8, .595).
- In only two of the previous 19 Solheim Cups were the teams tied after the first session (Day 1, Morning). That occurred in 2011 in Ireland (Europe ultimately won 15 to 13) and in 2015 in Germany (U.S. ultimately won 14.5 to 13.5)
- With a victory this morning, **Nelly Korda & Allisen Corpuz** improved their Solheim Cup record as a tandem to 5-0-0.
 - This is the first time a pair has ever won five matches in a row at the Solheim Cup.
 - Five points matches the all-time Solheim Cup record. **Laura Davies** and **Alison Nicholas** earned five points together (5-4-0).

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COMPETITION HIGHLIGHTS- FOUR-BALLS

- Captain Anna Nordqvist decided to put out the tandems of Charley Hull & Lottie Woad as well as Celine Boutier & Nanna Koerstz Madsen this afternoon despite both pairs losing their respective foursomes matches this morning.
 - This is the 10th and 11th time that a Solheim Cup captain has put out a team in the afternoon after they lost in the morning. Such teams are 6-3-0 in the afternoon matches.
- Team Europe had the advantage playing on the **first nine** holes of the golf course on Friday, winning 21 holes, losing 17 and tying 34.
- The U.S. Team had an advantage playing on the **second nine** holes of the golf course on Friday, winning 19 holes, losing 13 and tying 29.
- As a result, the American Team had three **come-from-behind** victories on Friday whereas the European Team had just one such win (Mimi Rhodes & Nastasia Nadaud trailed 1-down through six holes against Allisen Corpuz & Auston Kim).

WHAT THE PLAYERS SAID – FOUR-BALLS

"Not losing today was important. That half a point makes it 4-4 for the day and gives us good momentum going into tomorrow. I love this week. I just love playing for the team, for my teammates. Anna is a good friend of mine, so I just want to win for her."
