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COMPETITION HIGHLIGHTS - FOURSOMES

- European rookies Mimi Rhodes and Nastasia Nadaud became the first rookie duo to win two matches at one Solheim Cup
 - Their morning result of 4 and 3 matches the largest margin of victory by a rookie duo in a foursomes match
- Hole No. 10 played as the easiest on the course through the first three sessions at an average score of 4.083 and -0.917 under par
- With a win in her morning match (partnered with Esther Henseleit), Leona Maguire broke the record for fastest player to 10 wins in terms of matches played. She is 10-3-1 in overall matches played
- With a 6 and 5 win over Charley Hull and Lottie Woad, Lauren Coughlin (paired with Alison Lee this morning) improved her record to 5-0-2 (85.7%) which is the highest winning percentage in Solheim Cup history among those with at least five matches played.
 - Alison Lee is 3-0-0 this year
 - This tied the record for largest margin of victory in foursomes in Solheim Cup history
 - This was the largest defeat of Charley Hull's Solheim Cup career

WHAT THE PLAYERS SAID- FOURSOMES

"The crowd was amazing today. They really helped us turn the momentum on the back nine. Yeah, it was a lot of fun. It was a grind, but I feel like we still enjoyed it and kind of just made the best out of it. It's amazing."

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COMPETITION HIGHLIGHTS- FOUR-BALLS

- The duo of Charley Hull & Lottie Woad is the first ever to play **four sessions** together at one Solheim Cup
- Lauren Coughlin, closing in her 34th birth (on September 27), will become the oldest player to appear in all five sessions of one Solheim Cup since then-35-year-old Maria Hjorth went 2-1-2 for the European Team in 2009.
- Celine Boutier is the 11th different player to be paired with Carlota Ciganda in a Solheim Cup match. Only Laura Davies (12) has played with as many different Solheim Cup partners as Ciganda.
- Yealimi Noh leads the competitions in birdies or better made in four-ball with 13. No other player has more than 10.
- Prior to this year, there were 40 instances of a player playing in all four sessions prior to singles. All 40 earned at least 1 total point over the four matches.
 - Charley Hull, Lottie Woad, and Lauren Coughlin will be added to that list. So out of 43 total instances, Hull and Woad, both of whom earned .5 points so far this week, are the only two players to earn less than one full point.
- Historically, the U.S. has dominated Singles play in the Solheim Cup, leading 122.5 to 97.5 under that format.

WHAT THE PLAYERS SAID – FOUR-BALLS

"Not only was it super important for us to get a point on the leaderboard, but it just felt so good because we had such a great match. I played great on the front, Andrea played great on the back and we just really wanted to finish off with a win. We were like, we've got to get it done." *Yealimi Noh*

"Just to know that I know that Linn is not freaking out and she knows that I'm not freaking out. That makes you able to focus on yourself a lot more and you don't have to baby each other. Yeah, it's just really nice and you just kind of keep playing your own game." *Maja Stark*

"Walking up to the green, honestly, I just thought, okay, during all these practice rounds, I'd just get up and whack it. So I really didn't read it. I was like, we'll just give it a run, make sure we get it there, but what the heck it went in. That was insane." *Jennifer Kupcho*



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
