**Today** – A few passing showers are possible this morning, with most activity being light and of a brief duration. An area of low pressure moving across the Netherlands will bring likely chances for rain and isolated embedded thunderstorms this afternoon – with brief heavy downpours and wind gusts of 30-35 mph possible. Breezy to blustery winds are also expected outside of any rain on Wednesday, becoming sustained at 12-20 mph and gusting between 20-30 mph. **Forecast rainfall through 1900: 5 – 10 mm (0.20 – 0.40")** | **Sunrise: 0704 / Sunset: 2008**

**Extended forecast** – Precipitation should become more sporadic after 1900 Wednesday and will continue to diminish overnight. Expect partly sunny skies on Thursday with a stray light shower remaining possible. A weakening front could allow for some passing showers to occur on Friday. Areas of fog may develop Thursday and Saturday morning but should improve between 0800-0900 each day. Dry conditions return for much of Saturday, with just an isolated passing shower or patch of drizzle possible. Another frontal boundary will provide periods of rain on Sunday, but there remain differences in the model guidance regarding timing and total rainfall.
