TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

<u>Competition Format</u>: 16 teams consisting of two players, one LPGA Tour and one PGA TOUR; 54-holes, no cut

- Friday: Scramble
 - Each player hits a tee shot and then the team selects the ball to be used for the next stroke. From there, both players hit their next shots from that spot. This process continues until the ball is holed.
- Saturday: Foursomes
 - Each team's players alternate hitting shots with the same ball until the ball is holed. One player will tee off on the odd-numbered holes, and the other tees off on the even-numbered holes.
- Sunday: Modified Four-Ball
 - Both players tee off, and then they switch balls for their second shots and play that same ball until it is holed. The lower score of the partners is then counted as the team score for the hole.

Purse: \$4 million (\$2 million each Tour); winning team's portion is \$1 million (\$500,000 each)

Course History: Tiburón Golf Club

Located in Naples, Florida, Tiburón Golf Club features two 18-hole, Greg Norman-designed golf courses, The Gold and The Black. Tiburón's Gold Course opened in 1998 and the Black Course opened in 2001. The Gold Course hosts two professional events each year, the LPGA Tour's season ending CME Group Tour Championship and the joint LPGA Tour and PGA TOUR team event, the Grant Thronton Invitational. The PGA TOUR's QBE Shootout was formerly hosted on the Gold Course. The Chubb Classic, a Champions Tour Event, is hosted on the Black Course in February.

Tournament History: Grant Thornton Invitational

In its second year, the Grant Thornton Invitational is a mixed-team Challenge Season event that sees 16 LPGA Tour and 16 PGA TOUR professionals compete together in a unique co-sanctioned tournament. The three-day tournament showcases three different formats of team play and allows the 32-player field to compete for equal prize money and visibility. Lydia Ko and Jason Day won the inaugural event in 2023.
