Tournament Course Setup Notes and Daily Yardages

Grass Types and Cutting Heights	
Tees, Fairways and Rough:	Tees are Zoysia, cut to 8mm in the morning and afternoon. Fairways and Rough consist of Bermuda Celebration. Fairways are cut every morning and afternoon to 12mm.
Greens:	Greens consist of TifEagle, which is being cut to 3.1mm and rolled every morning and afternoon.
Approaches / Green Surrounds:	Approaches and Collars are Bermuda Celebration. Approaches are cut every morning to 10mm and Collars are cut to 8mm every morning and afternoon.
Golf Course and Site Information:	Since the 2008 Malaysian Open, the West Course at KLGCC has undergone a total redesign. Originally opened in 1991, Architects Ted Parslow and Jason Winter led the reconstruction in 2008 to make the West Course more undulated, feature more penalty areas (on a total of 13 holes) and tougher.
