Aon Insight

The final hole at the ShopRite LPGA Classic presented by Acer is a straight par 5 that demands precision off the tee. Accuracy is essential to safely navigate the bunkers lining both sides of the fairway and to have a chance at reaching the green in two shots. Based on where players stand on the leaderboard, they will need to decide on going for the green with their second shot or laying up to an ideal yardage to take advantage of this birdie opportunity. Extra length off the tee is always advantageous, but on the closing hole at Seaview Bay Course it's especially beneficial. Since 2021, players who drive the ball 280 yards or longer here have gained more than fourtenths of a stroke on average over those at 260 or shorter.

What is the Aon Risk Reward Challenge?

At the end of the regular season, the most consistent player on Tour, with the lowest average score under par, on the Aon Risk Reward Challenge holes captures the \$1 million prize and the Aon trophy.

Aon's Risk Reward Challenge Scoring

One hole is selected at each tournament as the designated Aon Risk Reward Challenge hole for the week (hole is strategically challenging in nature). For every participating event, a player's best two scores on the designated hole counts towards the season-long leaderboard.

The player with lowest average score under par across the regular season wins the Aon Risk Reward Challenge and will be awarded at the CME Group Tour Championship.

Aon and the PGA TOUR

The 2025 season will showcase the continuation of Aon's partnership with the PGA TOUR, which will integrate the use of real-time analytics and capitalize on changes to the TOUR's reimagined 2025 schedule.
