**Extended forecast** – Dry conditions will continue Wednesday and Thursday under mostly sunny to partly cloudy skies. Each afternoon will see southwesterly winds increase into the 10-15 mph range along with occasional gusts in the 16-20 mph range. Skies will become a mix of sun and clouds on Friday with an isolated pop-up shower or weak thunderstorm becoming possible in the afternoon or evening. A few showers and areas of fog may become possible Saturday morning ahead of an approaching cold front. After 2-3pm Saturday expect likely chances for rain and a few embedded thunderstorms that will persist into Saturday night. Outside an isolated shower expect that stable conditions will return for Sunday.
