Stark on the messages she has received on her major championship victory

"I think it was cool to see that Justin Rose was following along. Billie Jean King, got a message from her. Who else? I'm sure there are a lot of cool people. I haven't gone through all of my messages yet. I'm trying to do iMessage first. Not done with that."

# <u>Defending Champion Linnea Strom</u> Transcript | Video

Strom on what she remembers from her final round in 2024 and the significance of it

"I think it did after a while, and especially when people come up to me and call me Miss 60. It's pretty cool and fun to get reminded of it. So, yeah, it's obviously just proved that anything is possible. I think I have that in the back of my head going into this week, too, that I love this golf course; I know it's very scorable; but it can also be a little bit tricky, especially if the wind picks up. When I played yesterday I played pretty late in the afternoon. It was pretty windy, so some of the holes can be tough if the wind picks up for sure. But I think just having in the back of my head that anything is possible on this golf course."

Knight on the Seaview, Bay Course and what she likes about it

"h, every year it changes a little bit. I remember playing in COVID and it was really windy and firm and cold. I think it's just a really fun golf course to play. I think you need to be aggressive. It's only a three-day tournament. I think around 15-under normally wins. Yeah, not the longest golf course so really kind of placement golf a lot of shorter clubs in. Just have to be aggressive, and you know when it's windy it gets pretty tough. Yeah, I think if you looked -- I was just looking at the former champions. When Angela Stanford won in 2003 I think she shot 15-under, so it's always around that number, so you kind of know what to expect."

"Surprisingly it feels pretty good. I hadn't gotten cleared to take a full swing until May 13th. I was actually shocked how well I'm hitting it this week. I think there is no expectations, so I feel a little bit more relaxed. I remember last time I played in it I really grinded. I was playing KPMG that year, too. Am I as prepared as I want to be? Probably not. I been teaching a lot and it's been raining a lot up here. But I feel pretty good. I am taking care of my body and just trying to get some rest. This is a lot easier than teaching I think, just getting out there and playing. I've seen a lot of good friends this week, so it's been really fun."

# Monday Qualifier and Director of Instruction at Merion Golf Club, Joanna Coe Transcript | Video

Lopez on finding out she would be in the field this week

"Yeah, I didn't plan for it. I didn't expect it at all. I'm a PGA professional. Director of instruction at Merion, and had a complete full lesson book for the rest of the week. Had no plans. But I am playing in the KPMG Women's PGA Championship in a couple weeks, so I thought I should probably play against some women. Because in the Philadelphia PGA section we play -- I play mostly men so we play a little different tee. It's a very different game. I thought, you know what? Let me get used to women's golf again. Signed up on a whim. This course is special to me. I grew up here, so I know it extremely well. Yeah, it's really special to get in the field. I ended and three putted 18 for par. I'm like, hmm, I wonder if that was meaningful. I hope I didn't need to make birdie there to get in. I'm looking at the app and I have a three-shot lead, so that was pretty cool. Headed to McGettigan's to wait it out."

"Yeah, just finished my finals in two days like right before this tournament, and then finishing every assignment before school was over so I'm not crammed with all this stuff to do during a tournament. Just studying last week during the Open and tying to get it all done, and then coming out here and grinding some more is pretty tough."
